Description of services rendered: Condor Country Consulting performed a SFGS habitat assessment for a proposed culvert replacement at the Big Dipper Ranch, as well as a separate trapping study at Wool Ranch in La Honda for the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District. The primary purpose of this study was to determine whether SFGS were present on the property. Condor Country Consulting also performed a San Francisco garter snake habitat assessment in association with the proposed La Honda Trail on your property. The proposed route for the trail meanders from just north of



the La Honda Elementary School on Sears Ranch Road to a point less than one mile south of State Route 35 in San Mateo County, California.
